The number for all patients, the number and percentage for patients aged under 75 years and the number and percentage for patients aged over 75 years.

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

I attach, as requested,

- The numbers of patients who attended an ED for the timeframes outlined,
- The number of admissions for the same time period.

With regard to your requested data regarding Patient Experience Times (PETs) you should note that PET targets are monitored and reported in context of the following time bands:

- 6 Hours, 9 Hours, 24 Hours, greater than 24 Hours. I have therefore provided the available data.
